UNFINISHED BUSINESS

It was noted that Mr. Edward Trapp had submitted a 2018 schedule for the dismantling of the home at 9351 Drown which is in violation of the township's Dangerous Structure Ordinance.

NEW BUSINESS

It was noted that there were three proposals received for playground equipment and three proposals for two picnic shelters which would be installed at the Idyll Whyle Village Mobile Home Park under the township's CDBG Program. These proposals were submitted from Game Time, Play & Park Structures, and Sports and Recreation Associates. With no objections from the Board, it was recommended to the Erie County Department of Planning that Sports and Recreation Associates undertake the work for the construction of two 24x28 picnic shelters at a cost of \$59,000 and playground equipment at a cost of \$69,000.

Ron Bole moved that McKean Township enter into an Agreement with Erie Water Works for McKean Township to obtain certain maps owned by EWW, second by Brian Cooper and passed by unanimous roll call vote.

Jan Dennis moved that McKean Township acknowledges acceptance of the Request for Planning Waiver & Non-Building Declaration and further that the officials of McKean Township accept full responsibility to identify any violation of the non-building lot criteria of the subdivision of John Szymanowski and Michael Wheeler, second by Brian Cooper and passed by unanimous roll call vote.

Brian Cooper moved to approve the final Plans of Michael Wheeling and John Szymanowski for a minor subdivision on South Hill and Hamot Roads as submitted, second by Ron Bole and passed by unanimous roll call vote.

Jan Dennis moved to enact the following resolutions:

RESOLUTION NO. 1455

RESOLUTION OF THE SUPERVISORS OF McKEAN TOWNSHIP, ERIE COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA (hereinafter "the municipality")

WHEREAS Section 5 of the Act of January 24, 1966, P.L. 1535, known as the "Pennsylvania Sewage Facilities Act", as Amended, and the Rules and Regulations of the Pennsylvania Department of Environmental Protection (Department) adopted thereunder, Chapter 71 of Title 25 of the Pennsylvania Code, require the municipality to adopt an Official Sewage Facilities Plan providing for sewage services adequate to prevent contamination of waters of the Commonwealth and/or environmental health hazards from sewage wastes, and to revise said plan whenever it is necessary to determine whether a proposed method of sewage disposal for a new land development conforms to a comprehensive program of pollution control and water quality management, and

WHEREAS John Cole has proposed the development of a parcel of land identified as 10475 Old 99 and described in the Sewage Facilities Planning Module, and proposes that such subdivision be served by Single Residence Sewage Treatment Facility.

WHEREAS, McKean Township finds that the subdivision described in the Sewage Facilities Planning Module conforms to applicable sewage related zoning and other sewage related municipal ordinances and plans, and to a comprehensive program of pollution and water quality management.

NOW, THEREFIRE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Supervisors of McKean Township hereby adopt and submit to the Department of Environmental Protection for its approval as a revision to the "Official Sewage Facilities Plan" of the municipality the above referenced Sewage Facilities Planning Module.

Jan Dennis moved to authorize execution of the Transmittal Letter for Sewage Facilities Planning Module and the Maintenance Agreement Form for the John Cole SFTF, second by Brian Cooper and passed by unanimous roll call vote.

Ron Bole moved that the Stormwater Management Plan for the CNG Land Development Project at Sterrettania Road and I-90 is approved contingent upon an Operation and Maintenance Agreement be executed by the developer and the appropriate financial security be obtained for the stormwater management improvements, second by Brian Cooper and passed by unanimous roll call vote.

Ron reported that Franklin Township had lost their ambulance service and currently use West County Paramedics at a cost of \$400 per dispatch. Franklin Township is desiring to have McKean Hose Company provide emergency medical services to a certain portion of Franklin Township at a cost of \$300 per dispatch with Edinboro VFD providing service for the remaining portion of Franklin Township. McKean Hose Company's border would be all calls along Old State Road with Edinboro handling calls south of Old State Road.

Brian Cooper moved that McKean Township execute the signature page approving the Agreement between McKean Hose Company and Franklin Township for Emergency Medical Services, second by Ron Bole and passed by unanimous roll call vote.

PUBLIC PARTICIPATION

Charles Kanaar, Emergency Management Coordinator

Mr. Kanaar asked the township to provide him with the executed Hazard Mitigation Plan for the township and reported that there would be a siren test in McKean Township on April 15th at 12:30 p.m. He also requested addresses of our two sewage treatment plants as well as the chemical that are on site at the plants.

Molly Goldsmith, Skinner Road

Molly stated that she has a discussion with Joseph Szymanowski asking him not to waste township money as the court hearing regarding 2017 wages set by the Auditors is scheduled to take place on April 26th. She added that she has had no response from him.

Donald Klos, McDonald Road

Mr. Klos reported that there is a tree ready to fall onto McDonald Road.
