HEARING OF MCKEAN TOWNSHIP SUPERVISORS

CALL TO ORDER

A hearing of the Board of Supervisors was called to order on August 20, 2024 by Chair Janice Dennis at 3:30 p.m. as previously advertised by the Erie County Department of Planning and took place at the McKean Township Municipal bldg.

ROLL CALL

Members present were Janice Dennis and Brian Cooper. Member absent was Ronald Bole. Guest present was Tony Cunningham from the Erie County Department of Planning.

It was noted that there were no emails or correspondence received.

The purpose of this hearing was to identify the activity the Township proposes to use for its FY 2024 CDBG allocation and to take comments.

McKean Township is “entitled” to apply for and receive an annual allocation of CDBG funds from the PA DCED pursuant to PA Act 179 of 1984. The FY 2024 allocation is an estimated \$99,416. The deadline for the county to submit the application to DCED on behalf of the township is October 28, 2024.

Tony explained fundability and eligibility criteria for CDBG projects, and discussed past and potential future projects. Based upon comments from the first hearing and subsequent discussions with municipal officials

Participants went over future potential projects and were provided with a map of McKean Township’s LMI block group. The attendees discussed potential projects, and decided on pursuing a sewage plant project near Colonial Village, which is in an LMI block group. Tony will further research this project with DCED to ensure that it is a fundable project.

Tony also updated the supervisors on the 2020 Single Family Home Rehabilitation Project. There are currently 10 applicants to the program which will be carefully tracked and supported by Mr. Cunningham. 3 of these applicants have been deemed viable so far.

It was determined further that if the sewage plant was not a fundable, project 2024 funds would be used for single family rehabilitation projects.

ADJOURNMENT

With no objections, the meeting was adjourned at 4:00 p.m.
